Paramedic/Firefighter

East Fork Fire and Paramedic Districts

This testing will establish an eligibility list to fill future vacancies. Written and oral testing addressing EMS, Fire and related topics will be administered after the closing date.

The eligibility list, once established, will be used to fill future positions for 56 hour per week shift schedules and will remain in effect for maximum of two (2) years.

Responsibilities

This position responds to medical emergencies and other calls to protect life and property including fire suppression, alarms; participates in fire prevention, training, station and equipment activities.

Minimum Requirements

- High School Diploma or General Education Degree (GED) and completion of paramedic education program recognized for National Registry or State of Nevada certification.
- Paramedic Certification that is either Nevada EMT-Advanced or National Registry. Certification must be current and must not have been revoked, suspended, terminated or subject to any current disciplinary action.
- Firefighter-I meeting the requirements of NFPA 1001. Certification must be Nevada or other certifying agency accredited by the International Fire Service Accreditation Council (IFSAC). Incident Command System-100 and -200 course completion within six months of employment
- Upon approval of employment, the applicant will be required to obtain Nevada State ambulance attendant licensure and paramedic certification from the State of Nevada Health Division – Office of Emergency Medical Services.
- Must possess a valid driver's license with an acceptable driving record (**DMV printout required with application**). Must have the ability to obtain Nevada Class B with "F" exemption or restricted Class B Fire Fighter driver's license or higher driver's license within 6 months of employment.
- Applicants must possess current documentation of successful completion of Candidate Physical Abilities Testing (CPAT) from a licensed CPAT testing facility by date of written testing. To find the closest CPAT test, visit <http://www.cffjac.org/go/jac/cpat/>

Testing

Tentative date for the test is March 30, 2012. Individuals must bring a photo ID and a copy of their CPAT testing results to the test date no exceptions. Interview dates will be determined following the test completion. There is a non-refundable \$35.00 testing fee required at the time of being invited to the written test payable by cashiers check or money order. (Payable to East Fork Fire and Paramedic Districts or EFFPD). _
