### SUMMARY OF JOB PURPOSE

Performs professional legal work relating to criminal law with moderate supervision from, or in consultation with, the Chief Criminal Deputy District Attorney, Assistant District Attorney, or the District Attorney.

### ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

1. Represents the State in criminal prosecutions at misdemeanor, gross misdemeanor and felony levels. More complex and serious criminal matters will be prosecuted under direct supervision or on a co-counsel basis with more experienced deputies.
2. Reviews police reports and investigations conducted in support of prospective charges.
3. Authorizes and drafts criminal complaints and other legal documents in support of criminal prosecutions.
4. Prepares and presents the State's case at preliminary hearings, before the Grand Jury and at trial.
5. Advises County officials and employees on the legal propriety of proposed actions taken in the context of the criminal justice system or the performance of official duties in a non-criminal law context.
6. Searches for, interprets, and applies laws, court decision, and other legal authorities in preparation of briefs or legal opinions.
7. Acts as a 24-hour, on-call deputy on a rotating basis for giving legal advice to the Sheriff or for other emergencies.
